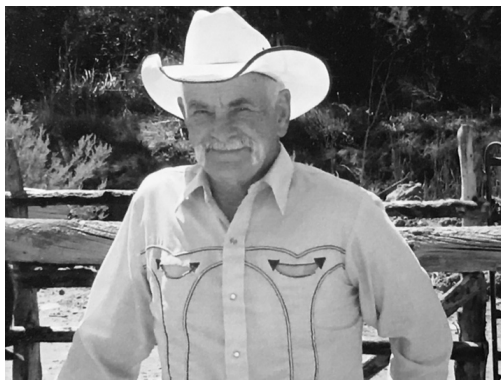
Prominent features: his emerald eyes. Lots of bushy gray hair grows out it ears. He smells of grass and the earth with a hint of chewing tobacco.
